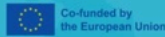

Exploring New Horizons: First Workshop with CoVE T-Shore

One of the highlights of the meeting was our first **workshop with CoVE T-Shore**. This session focused on **wind energy** and its potential for cooperation between tourism and energy sectors. We discussed a wide range of topics, including **wind turbine technician training** and **marine coordination**. By leveraging the expertise from both the tourism and energy industries, we aim to create new training pathways that link **tourism management, hospitality, and environmental sustainability**. CoVEs across sectors share common objectives, making the CoVE concept an ideal model for building strong regional partnerships.

Research and Focus Groups: Piloting Vocational Excellence

In parallel, we've been focusing on **research** and **self-assessment** in **vocational excellence**. Through focus groups conducted in **7 countries**, we engaged with local stakeholders and experts to identify the key skills and knowledge needed for future tourism careers. This initiative, part of the **Erasmus+ project Cove TourX**, explores areas such as **hospitality**, **tourism management**, and **catering**, with the aim of fostering **professional excellence** in the tourism industry.
